Role Overview

Summer Fellows will serve as frontline organizers, responsible for engaging voters, supporting campaign events, and helping execute the field strategy across the district.

This is a fast-paced, field-based role where fellows are expected to take initiative, meet clear goals, and work closely with campaign staff to drive results.

No prior campaign experience is required. We are looking for people who are motivated, reliable, and ready to learn.

Key Responsibilities

Field Organizing

- Conduct door-to-door canvassing and direct voter outreach
- Participate in canvass launches and campaign events
- Meet weekly voter contact goals
- Recruit volunteers and supporters

Student & Community Engagement

- Table at events and high-traffic locations
- Engage peers and community members in conversations about the campaign
- Build relationships that expand the campaign's reach

Relational Organizing

- Follow up with voters and supporters through text, phone, and in-person outreach
- Help build a network of engaged supporters in your community

Data & Reporting

- Accurately log all voter interactions
- Track progress toward weekly goals
- Communicate regularly with campaign staff

- Strong communication and interpersonal skills
- Self-motivated with a willingness to take initiative
- Organized and able to manage time effectively

- Comfortable working toward clear goals in a team environment
- Passion for public service, politics, or community organizing

Program Details

- Field-based role located in Virginia (Charlottesville, Blacksburg, Lynchburg, Harrisonburg, or Roanoke)
- Full-time commitment during the program
- Includes structured training, mentorship, and hands-on campaign experience

Fellows who demonstrate strong performance and leadership will have the opportunity to continue with the campaign in expanded roles during the fall.

Compensation

Fellows will be compensated at a rate of \$15 per hour, with hours varying based on campaign needs and availability.
